Red Chili peppers

Super decorative on a wooden board! A strand with peppers that are drying! Hang them in your kitchen and it looks like there are real peppers hanging! Also nice to combine with a board with a strand of garlic on it.

Used Materials:

Cotton yarn in different shades of red/burgundy for the chili peppers. You can make it with all kinds of leftovers.
Green or brown for the stems.
Hemp rope or sisal rope to make the braid.
A wooden cutting board, a decorative nail
Scissors, needle, fibrefill

Red Chili

Start with red/burgundy

- Rnd. 1. 4SC in MR (4)
- Rnd. 2 - 3. 4SC (4)
- Rnd. 4. 2SC in 1,3SC (5)
- Rnd. 5. 5SC (5)
- Rnd. 6. 2SC in 1SC, 4SC (6)
- Rnd. 7. 6SC (6)
- Rnd. 8. 2SC in 1SC, 5SC (7)
- Rnd. 9. 2SC in 1SC, 6SC (8)
- Rnd. 10. 8SC (8)
- Rnd. 11. 2SC in 1SC, 7SC (9)
- Rnd. 12. 2SC in 1SC, 8SC (10)
- Rnd. 13. 2SC in 1SC, 9SC (11)
- Rnd. 14. 2SC in 1SC, 10SC (12)
- Rnd. 15 - 17. 12SC (12)
- Rnd. 18. 2SC together, 10SC (11)
- Rnd. 19. 11SC (11)
- Rnd. 20. 2SC in 1SC, 10SC (12)
- Rnd. 21. 2SC in 1SC, 11SC (13)
- Rnd. 22 - 23. 13SC (13)
- Rnd. 24. 2SC in 1SC, 12SC (14)
- Rnd. 25 - 26. 14SC (14)
- Rnd. 27. 2SC together, 12SC (13)
- Rnd. 28. 13SC (13)
- Rnd. 29. 2SC together, 11SC (12)
- Rnd. 30 - 31. 12SC (12)

Used stitches and abbreviations (US terms)

MR	: Magical Ring
SC	: Single Crochet
HDC	: Half Double Crochet
2SC in 1	: Increase
2SC together	: Decrease
CH	: Chain



Stuff the chili. It does not really have to be very neat, it can be quite whimsical. After all, they become dried peppers.

Change to green for the stem. Use can use a brown colour as well.

- Rnd. 32. 12SC (12)
- Rnd. 33. (2SC together) repeat 6x (6)
- Rnd. 34. 4SC, 2SC together (5)
- Rnd. 35. Close Rnd. 34 with 2SC, 1CH, turn (2)
- Rnd. 36 and further. Crochet a few times: 1HDC, 1CH, turn, until the stem is long enough to attach to the braid. Fasten off.

Make as many chili peppers as you need.

Take a little cutting board.

Turn raffia/sisal/hemp rope into a braid that fits on the shelf. Attach it with a decorative nail. Sew the chili peppers to the braid, work from bottom to top.
