Bookmark Little Flower

A super cute little flower as a bookmark, to put in your favourite crochet book or reading book!

Used Materials:

A little bit of cotton yarn, colours pink, yellow and green. Crochet hook 2.5 Scissors and needle

Used stitches and abbreviations (US terms):

CH : Chain

SC : Single Crochet SLST : Slip Stitch

HDC : Half Double Crochet

DC : Double Crochet

MR : Magical Ring

25C in 1 : Increase

Little Flower

Pink

Rnd. 1. 65C in MR (6)

Rnd. 2. Back Loops Only: 25C in every stitch (12)

Rnd. **3**. Back Loops Only: [(1SLST, 2CH, 1DC) in 1 stitch, (2DC in 1 stitch), (1DC, 2CH, 1SLST) in 1 stitch] Repeat between [...] $4 \times$



Rnd. **4**. 1L, Front Loops Only of Rnd. 3: [(1SLST, 2CH, 1DC) in 1 stitch, 1DC, (1DC, 2CH, 1SLST) in 1 stitch] Repeat between [...] $4 \times$

Rnd. **5**. 1L, Front Loops Only of Rnd. 2: [(1SLST, 2CH, 1DC) in 1 stitch, (1DC, 2CH, 1SLST) in 1 stitch] Repeat between [...] 3×10^{-1}

Fasten off.

Take a yellow thread and make a few French knots in the middle of the flower.

Stem

Green

Rnd. 1. 5CH

Rnd. 2. From 2nd CH: 45C, 1CH, turn

Rnd. **3**. 45C, 15C in the last CH of Rnd. 1.

Rnd. 4. 56CH (crochet more or less, depending how long your stem must be.)

Rnd. 5. From 2nd CH: 30SLST, 8CH, from 2nd CH: 1SLST, 1SC, 1HDC, 1DC, 1HDC, 1SC,

1SLST, crochet on the long Chain again: 25SLST, 1SLST in the last SC of Rnd. 3.

If you want you can make the leaf closer to the flower.

Fasten off, leave a long thread.

Sew the stem on the back of the flower.
