Baby Funnies

These Funnies are fun to hang in a baby room, for a baby shower or as baptismal sugars!
Or you just hang them on your bag!

Used materials:

Lammy Yarns Rio, cotton, or Scheepjes Catania, for the head: 8gr

Bits of cotton to make the hat and the eyes.

If you use different thicknesses of yarn it might happen that a hat is just too big or too small!

Crochet hook 2,5, scissors, needle blunt and pointy, fibrefill.

Fake fur pompom of about 10cm, fake fur circle which has a diameter of about 16cm.

Key rings/keychain, ribbon, Charm

Used stitches and abbreviations (US term.):

CH: Chain Stitch

SC: Single Crochet

SLST: Slip Stitch

HDC: Half Double Crochet

DC: Double Crochet

MR: Magical Ring

2SC in 1: Increase

2SC together: Decrease

DC without a foundation chain.

Head

Rnd. 1. 6SC in MR	(6)
Rnd. 2. 2SC in every SC	(12)
Rnd. 3. (1SC, 2SC in 1SC) repeat 6x	(18)
Rnd. 4. (2SC, 2SC in 1SC) repeat 6x	(24)
Rnd. 5. 1SC, 2SC in 1SC, (3SC, 2SC in 1SC) 5x, 2SC	(30)
Rnd. 6. (4SC, 2SC in 1SC) repeat 6x	(36)
Rnd. 7. 1SC, 2SC in 1SC, (5SC, 2SC in 1SC) 5x, 4SC	(42)
Rnd. 8 - 14. 42SC	(42)
Rnd. 15. (5SC, 2SC together) repeat 6x	(36)
Rnd. 16. (4SC, 2SC together) repeat 6x	(30)
Rnd. 17. (3SC, 2SC together) repeat 6x	(24)
Rnd. 18. (2SC, 2SC together) repeat 6x	(18)
Stuff the head.	
Rnd. 19. (1SC, 2SC together) repeat 6x	(12)
Rnd. 20. (2SC together) repeat 6x	(6)

Close the head, fasten off and leave a long thread to sew the head on the pompon.



Embroider a nose and sleepy eyes.

Hats

Crochet alternating 2 Rnds white and 2 Rnds blue or pink. To keep the changing of the colours above each other I regularly crochet 1 fixed SC extra, and applied the colour switch than. There you will start the next Rnd.. The hat might be a little longer, but that's just fun!

Baby hat pink white

- Rnd. 1.** 36DC without a foundation chain, loosely, close with a SLST. (36)
- Rnd. 2.** Back Loops Only: 36SC (36)
- Rnd. 3 - 8.** 36SC (36)
- Rnd. 9.** 9SC, skip 18 stitches, 9SC (18)
- Rnd. 10 - 15.** 18SC (18)
- Rnd. 16.** (7SC, 2SC together) repeat 2x (16)
- Rnd. 17 - 18.** 16SC (16)
- Rnd. 19.** (6SC, 2SC together) repeat 2x (14)
- Rnd. 20 - 22.** 14SC (14)
- Rnd. 23.** (5SC, 2SC together) repeat 2x (12)
- Rnd. 24 - 25.** 12SC (12)
- Rnd. 26.** (2SC, 2SC together) repeat 3x (9)
- Rnd. 17 - 29.** 9SC (9)
- Rnd. 30.** (1SC, 2SC together) repeat 3x (6)
- Rnd. 31.** 6SC (6)
- Fasten off.

Repeat Rnd. 9 - Rnd. 31. Again on the other 18 stitches of Rnd. 8.

Roll the two parts and fasten them with a few stitches. Fasten the hat on the head with a few stitches. Attach a tab or key ring to the hat.



Baby hat blue white

- Rnd. 1. 36DC without a foundation chain, loosely, close with a SLST. (36)
- Rnd. 2. Back Loops Only: 36SC (35)
- Rnd. 3. 34SC, 2SC together (34)
- Rnd. 4. 33SC, 2SC together (33)
- Rnd. 5. 32SC, 2SC together (32)
- Rnd. 6. 31SC, 2SC together (31)
- Rnd. 7. 30SC, 2SC together (30)
- Rnd. 8. 29SC, 2SC together (29)
- Rnd. 9. 28SC, 2SC together (28)
- Rnd. 10. 27SC, 2SC together (27)
- Rnd. 11. 26SC, 2SC together (26)
- Rnd. 12. 25SC, 2SC together (25)
- Rnd. 13. 24SC, 2SC together (24)
- Rnd. 14. 23SC, 2SC together (23)
- Rnd. 15. 22SC, 2SC together (22)
- Rnd. 16. 21SC, 2SC together (21)
- Rnd. 17. 20SC, 2SC together (20)
- Rnd. 18. 19SC, 2SC together (19)
- Rnd. 19. 18SC, 2SC together (18)
- Rnd. 20. 17SC, 2SC together (17)
- Rnd. 21. 16SC, 2SC together (16)
- Rnd. 22. 15SC, 2SC together (15)
- Rnd. 23. 14SC, 2SC together (14)
- Rnd. 24. 13SC, 2SC together (13)
- Rnd. 25. 12SC, 2SC together

- Rnd. 26. 11SC, 2SC together (12)
 Rnd. 27. 10SC, 2SC together (11)
 Rnd. 28. 9SC, 2SC together (10)
 Rnd. 29. 8SC, 2SC together (9)
 Rnd. 30. 7SC, 2SC together (8)
 Rnd. 31. 6SC, 2SC together (7)
 Rnd. 32. 5SC, 2SC together (6)
 Fasten off.

Roll the hat and fasten it with a few stitches.

Fasten the hat on the head with a few stitches. Attach a tab or key ring to the hat.



Sew the head to the pom-pom with a pointed needle.

Tie a ribbon around the neck and hang a charm on the ribbon.
