

Wobbly Bird!

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Material:

Wobbly Bird (Action)

Cotton in the colours you like, a bit of fluffy yarn.

A little bit of fibrefill, wobbly eyes.

Scissors, needle, crochet hook 2.5, textile glue, plier/tweets, sandpaper



Used Stitches and abbreviations (US term.):

SLST: Slip Stitch MR: Magical Ring SC: Single Crochet CH: Chain 25C in 15C: Increase 25C together: Decrease HDC: Half Double Crochet

However cute this bird is, we will first take off all parts, use the tweets. Use the file or sandpaper for the sharp edges.

stitch, 1SLST.

Rnd. 1. 65C in MR	(6)
Rnd. 2. 25C in every SC	(12)
Rnd. 3. (15C, 25C in 15C) 6x	(18)
Rnd. 4. (25C, 25C in 15C) 6x	(24)
Rnd. 5. 15C, 25C in 15C, (35C, 25C in 15C) 5x, 25C	(30)
Rnd. 6. (45C, 25C in 15C) 6x	(36)
Rnd. 7. (85C, 25C in 15C) 4x	(40)
Rnd. 8. 405C	(40)
Rnd. 9. (95C, 25C in 15C) 4x	(44)
Rnd. 10 - 11. 445C	(44)
Rnd . 12. (215C, 25C in 15C) 2x	(46)
Rnd . 13. (225C, 25C in 15C) 2x	(48)
Rnd. 14 - 15. 485C	(48)
Rnd. 16. (235C, 25C in 15C) 2x	(50)
Rnd. 17 - 19. 505C	(50)
Rnd 20 (skin 1 stitch 3HDC skin 1 stitch 1SLST) reneat until end of the Rnd	skin 1

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Fasten off. Put the body around the bare bird.

Head

Rnd. 1. 65C in MR	(6)
Rnd. 2. 25C in every SC	(12)
Rnd . 3 . (15C, 25C in 15C) 6x	(18)
Rnd . 4 . (25C, 25C in 15C) 6x	(24)
Rnd . 5 . 15C, 25C in 15C, (35C, 25C in 15C) 5x, 25C	(30)
Rnd . 6 . (45C, 25C in 15C) 6x	(36)
Rnd. 7 - 11. 365C	(36)
Rnd . 12. (45C, 25C together) 6x	(30)
Rnd . 13. (35C, 25C together) 6x	(24)
Rnd. 14. (25C, 25C together) 6x	(18)
Rnd . 15 . 185 <i>C</i>	(18)

Fasten off, leave a long thread. Stuff the head and sew it on the body. Not exactly in the middle, but slightly forward. You could just pin it first, take of the body and sew it together.

Beak

Rnd. 1. 4SC in MR	(4)
Rnd. 2. 45C	(4)
Rnd. 3 . 25C in 15C, 35C	(5)
Rnd. 4. 25C in 15C, 45C	(6)
Rnd. 5 . 25 <i>C</i> in 15 <i>C</i> , 55 <i>C</i>	(7)
Rnd. 6. 25C in 15C, 65C	(8)
Rnd. 7. (35C, 25C in 15C) 2x	(10)
Rnd. 8. 105C.	(10)
Francisco (C. Langerto and C. C. C. Alexandra de Carrello de Carre	

Fasten off, leave a long thread. Stuff the beak and sew it on the head.

Glue two wobbly eyes on the head.

Wing (make 2)

Rnd. 1. 65C in MR

From here Back Loops Only

Rnd. 2. 25C in every 5C

Rnd. **3**. (15C, 25C in 15C) 6x

Rnd. 4. (25C, 25C in 15C) 6x

Rnd. 5. 15C, 25C in 15C, (35C, 25C in 15C) 5x, 25C

Rnd. 6 - 8. 305C

Rnd. **9**. (85C, 25C together) 3x

Rnd. **10**. (75C, 25C together) 3x

Rnd. 11, 245C

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Rnd. 12. (25C, 25C together) 6x	(18)
Rnd. 13. (75C, 25C together) 2x	(16)
Rnd. 14. (25C, 25Ctogether) 4x	(12)
Rnd. 15. (45C, 25C together) 2x	(10)
Rnd. 16. (35C, 25C together) 2x	(8)
Rnd. 17. (25C, 25C together) 2x	(6)

Put a little piece of chenille thread or iron thread in the wing, if you want to bend it. Fasten off, close and flatten.

Sew the wings on the body.

Tail feathers (make 3)

Start with cotton

Rnd. 1. 10CH

Rnd. 2. From 2nd CH: 85C, 35C in last CH, on the other site of the chain: 85C. Fasten off, leave a long thread.

With fluffy yarn, start in the 1st SC of Rnd. 2:

Rnd. 3. 195C

Fasten off.

Sew the feathers on the back of the body.

On the head I sewed a little piece of fluffy yarn, I used a bigger crochet hook: 3CH, from 2nd CH: (2SC in 1) 2x. Fasten off and sew it on. Have fun wobbling!





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
