

Vintage Christmas Tree

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This cute little Christmas Tree can be made in 2 different ways, just from 1 pattern. You will make a round version or a more flat triangle shape tree.

Find some thin sticks outside to use as tree trunk. Use a small disk of a stick of a tree as standard. Find some nice decorations for your tree.

Used Materials:

Zeeman Royal (100% acrylic yarn, 100gr/240m) Crochet hook 3 Scissors, needle, stuffing, a stick and disc of a tree and some decorations. Maybe a drill and a saw to saw a disc of a stick of a tree and to drill a hole in it.

Used stitches and abbreviations (US term.):

MR	: Magical Ring
SC	: Single Crochet
25C in 1	: Increase
2SC together	: Decrease

Tree

Rnd. 1. 6SC in MR	(6)
Rnd. 2. 65C	(6)
Rnd. 3. (1SC, 2SC in 1SC) repeat 3x	(9)
Rnd. 4. 95C	(9)
Rnd. 5. (2SC, 2SC in 1SC) repeat 3x	(12)
Rnd. 6. 125C	(12)
Rnd. 7. 15C, 25C in 15C, (35C, 25C in 15C) 2x, 25C	(15)
Rnd. 8 - 9. 155C	(15)
Rnd. 10. (4SC, 2SC in 1SC) repeat 3x	(18)
Rnd. 11 - 12. 185C	(18)
Rnd. 13. 15C, 2SC in 1SC, (5SC, 2SC in 1SC) 2x, 4SC	(21)
Rnd. 14 - 15. 215C	(21)
Rnd . 16. (6SC, 2SC in 1SC) repeat 3x	(24)
Rnd. 17 - 18. 245C	(24)
Rnd. 19. 25C, 25C in 15C, (7SC, 25C in 15C) 2x, 55C	(27)
Rnd. 20. 135C, 25C in 15C, 135C	(28)
Rnd. 21. 285C	(28)
Rnd . 22 . (6SC, 2SC in 1SC) repeat 4x	(32)
Rnd. 23 - 25. 325C	(32)
Rnd. 26. 25C, 25C in 15C, (7SC, 25C in 15C) 3x, 55C	(36)
Rnd. 27 - 29. 365C	(36)
Rnd . 30 . (85C, 25C in 15C) repeat 4x	(40)
Rnd. 31 - 33. 405C	(40)

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Stuff the tree. Do you want to make a round tree, stuff firmly. Do you want a smaller triangle shape tree, do not stuff too much.

Do you want a round tree, fasten off and start crocheting the bottom.

Do you want a smaller triangle shape tree, continue with Rnd. 34.

Rnd. 34. Back Loops Only: (2SC together) 2x, 13SC, (2SC together) 3x, 15SC, 2SC together (34) Fasten off. Leave a long thread. Sew Rnd. 34 together, using the back loops. Do not forget to put the tree trunk in your tree first.

Bottom

Rnd. 1. 6SC in MR	(6)
Do not pull the MR too tight, the tree trunk must fit in it.	
Rnd. 2. 2SC in every SC	(12)
Rnd. 3. (1SC, 2SC in 1SC) repeat 6x	(18)
Rnd. 4. (2SC, 2SC in 1SC) repeat 6x	(24)
Rnd. 5. 1SC, 2SC in 1SC, (2SC, 2SC in 1SC) 7x, 1SC	(32)
Rnd. 6. (3SC, 2SC in 1) repeat 8x	(40)
Fasten off, leave a long thread.	

Put the stick in the tree, slide the bottom on top. Pull the MR. Sew the bottom to the tree using the opposite loops (outside loops of the bottom, inside loops of the tree)

Start decorating!



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
