

Garlic

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Garlic bulbs

Very decorative and a cute little project to make.

Used materials:

Cotton yarn in the colours light brown and cream colour. I used a little bit of the light brown yarn and almost 40gr of the cream colour to make 5 bulbs.

Crochet hook 2.5

Scissors, long needle, fibrefill, tweezers to pull the needle through the garlic bulb.

If you want to attach the garlic to a plank then you also need: a plank, a nail, sisal rope to make a braid and hang the garlic on (you can also take cotton yarn and braid or crochet a chain) and a nail to hang the braid on the plank. A hammer to put the nail in the shelf.

Used stitches and abbreviations (US term.):

MR : Magical Ring SC : Single Crochet

25C in 15C : Increase 2SC together : Decrease

I made 2 types/size of garlic.

Garlic 1

Crochet every Round in Back Loops Only! Light brown

Rnd. 1. 6SC in MR	(6)
Rnd. 2. 25C in every SC	(12)
Rnd. 3. (15C, 25C in 15C) repeat 6x	(18)
Change to cream colour	
Rnd. 4. (25C, 25C in 15C) repeat 6x	(24)
Rnd. 5. 15C, 25C in 15C, (35C, 25C in 15C) 5x, 25C	(30)
Rnd. 6. (45C, 25C in 15C) repeat 6x	(36)
Rnd. 7. 25C, 25C in 15C, (5SC, 2SC in 1SC) 5x, 3SC	(42)
Rnd. 8 - 13. 425C	(42)
Rnd 14 (55C 25C together) repeat 6x	(36)

Rnd. 14. (55C, 25C together) repeat 6x	(36)
Rnd. 15. (4SC, 2SC together) repeat 6x	(30)

Rnd. 16.
$$(35C, 25C \text{ together})$$
 repeat $6x$ (24)

Stuff the garlic.

Rnd. 19. (25C together) repeat 6x (6)

The next Rnds you can crochet through both loops again

Rnd. 20 - 24, 65C (6)

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Would you rather have a longer stalk, crochet a couple of Rnds extra. Fasten off. Leave a thread to sew the garlic on the braid.

Garlic 2

Rnd. 21 - 25. 65C

Crochet every Round in Back Loops Only!

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Light brown	
Rnd . 1. 65C in MR	(6)
Rnd. 2. 25C in every 5C	(12)
Rnd. 3. (15C, 25C in 15C) repeat 6x	(18)
Change to cream colour	
Rnd. 4. (25C, 25C in 15C) repeat 6x	(24)
Rnd. 5. 15C, 25C in 15C, (35C, 25C in 15C) 5x, 25C	(30)
Rnd. 6. (45C, 25C in 15C) repeat 6x	(36)
Rnd. 7. 25C, 25C in 15C, (55C, 25C in 15C) 5x, 35C	(42)
Rnd. 8 - 11. 425C	(42)
Rnd. 12. (5SC, 2SC together) repeat 6x	(36)
Rnd. 13. 365C	(36)
Rnd. 14. (4SC, 2SC together) repeat 6x	(30)
Rnd. 15. 30 <i>SC</i>	(30)
Rnd. 16. (35C, 25C together) repeat 6x	(24)
Rnd. 17. 245C	(24)
Rnd. 18. (25C, 25C together) repeat 6x	(18)
Stuff the garlic.	
Rnd. 19. (15C, 25C together) repeat 6x	(12)
Rnd. 20. (25C together) repeat 6x	(6)
The next Rnds you can crochet through both loops again	

Would you rather have a longer stalk, crochet a couple of Rnds extra. Fasten off. Leave a thread to sew the garlic on the braid.

Take a long thread of cream colour yarn and a needle. Tie a knot at the end of the thread. Go with the needle between Rnd. 18 and Rnd. 19 (beginning) through the middle to the bottom. Now pull the thread under the front loops of the Rnds. up to the beginning, back through the middle to the bottom and tighten/pull the thread. Repeat this. This way you divide the garlic into wedges. Always pull the wire. If you have enough wedges, fasten off.

Make as many as you like!

Cut pieces of light brown cotton. Tie the threads in the front loops of Rnd. 1-3. Cut them at the right length. Brush them a bit.

Make a braid of Sisal rope or other material and sew the garlic to it.

Hang the braid with a little nail on the shelf and your garlic decoration is ready!
